### **ITEM # 1: Welcome address by the Chairman, IETE Hyderabad Centre**

Chairman, IETE, Hyderabad Centre welcomed all the Corporate members. Notable among the attendees were Prof. (Dr) V. Gunasekhar Reddy, President IETE, Dr. K. Seetharam Babu, GC Member( Org.) attended the AGM

### **ITEM # 2: To confirm the minutes of Previous Annual General Body Meeting held on 26<sup>th</sup> June, 2022**

The Chairman read the minutes of previous Annual General Body Meeting held on 26th June 2022 with adopted resolutions.

Dr. Nookala Srinivasa Rao, Honorary Treasurer presented the Account details and balance sheet. There was a query about the increase in R & D expenditure compared to the Income generated

It is explained that IETE, Hyderabad Centre wanted to establish a center of excellence for “Block Chain Technology” as per the directives of IETE Head Quarters. In view of this and to gauge the potential of “Block Chain Technology course” initially we have conducted three Webinars and Two Workshops on “Block Chain Technology”. The required software being an expensive, it was obtaining by paying rent for two days Hands on Workshop.

It is suggested to continue with the same Auditor for the coming year also. Only the suggestions was given by Prof. (Dr) V. Gunasekhar Reddy to maintain the heads as it used to be earlier and follow the same accounting practice as earlier.

**ITEM # 6: Any Other item with the permission of the Chair**

Chairman, IETE Hyderabad informed that few of Executive Committee members (EC) are not attending due to the following reasons

- a) Sri Dheeraj K Deshpande belongs to Gulbarga, as Gulbarga became an independent IETE center. It is unanimously agreed to induct. Dr. D. Ranganadham (F-161881) Dy. Director General, DD as executive committee member(EC) in place of Sri. Dheeraj K Deshpande,
- b) Sri S.Arvind EC member Hyderabad has submitted his resignation due to the personal reasons stating that his nature of work is not permitting him to devote time to carryout IETE activities and in his place Dr. V. Rama Rao included as EC Member.
- c) Smt. Dr. P.A. Harsha Vardhini, EC member expressed difficulties in attending the IETE activities and submitted the resignation and in her place Dr. I Sharat Chandra, Professor in Matrusri Engineering College included as EC member.

Prof. (Dr) V. Gunasekhar Reddy, wanted to know about status on the suggestions given in last AGM meeting Sri. Ashwani Kumar Sangamker, Hony. Secretary, explained that regarding the “Short Time Bridge Courses” an attempt was made by inviting the students and Corporate employees. Due to poor response and reluctance to attend physically at the IETE premises, Online courses were conducted as a part of knowledge sharing Webinars for “Stress Management , Leader ship skills and etc.” , Online courses were well received.

Dr. KVNL Narasimham asked about the efforts put in getting recognition for IETE courses. Dr. V.Gunasekhar Reddy, President IETE informed that in today’s scenario every thing has to be done by considering the “ Return on Investment”. Through lot of efforts has been put in establishing university at Ranchi and subsequently at Manipur, not much progress has happened. Infact Manipur does not have any private University as on today. Opportunity exists in conducting short time courses and Diploma in Cyber Security, which may fetch good returns to IETE. Also he suggested to tie up with NIELIT for skill developing programs. He has quoted that at Noida, IETE Centre a course has been started in IC designing in collaboration with NIELIT for chip manufacturing, same can be tried at Hyderabad IETE center also.

Dr. Nookala Srinivasa Rao delivered vote of Thanks. He thanked all the EC, GC members and the co-operate members for smooth functioning of IETE Hyderabad.
