Annual IETE Convention

Frontier Information & Emp; Communication technologies for Atmanirbhar Bharat

"The Prime Minister's call for Atmanirbhar Bharat has galvanised the entire manufacturing sector in the country, including in particular the Information and Communications technologies," said Dr.G.Satheesh Reddy, Scientific Advisor to Raksha Mantri, while addressing the Annual Convention of the Institution of Electronics and Telecommunication Engineers (IETE) at Hyderabad on Sunday, Sep 25. "Till recently, even simple things like routers, servers, switches etc. were all being imported but now, thanks to the PM's visionary leadership, the situation has changed dramatically. The information and communication technologies are at the core of this programme and IETE can play a leading role in this context with its nationwide presence of eminent engineers and scientists in different areas of specialisation." Dr. Reddy was the Chief Guest at the two-day Convention attended by a cross section of IETE's corporate members, leading industrialists, academia and engineering scholars from different parts of the country.

Nonagenarian and Padma Sree awardee Dr. T.H. Chowdary, who was the Guest of Honour at the event, while recalling his long association with IETE, suggested that the electromagnetic spectrum, being a natural resource like air and water, should not be subjected to sale/auction by the government. Rather, it should be made free, so that cost of communications can be drastically reduced for the benefit of the poor. IETE should prevail upon the government for necessary policy changes in this regard, he said.

TedX speaker, Thousands of college students and professionals got benefited by his lectures which are delivered at IITs, Central Universities, IIMs, 350+ Engineering colleges all over India. He was rewarded by IAS officers for pentesting on govt sites, which helped to them to improve security and safe transactions, Forensic Investigator.

The session was very interactive and students participated enthusiastically. In the beginning Mr Sai Satish gave the introduction on Artificial intelligence (AI) which is a broad term that can be construed to mean a focus in computer programming and development designed to train machines to perform tasks as well as, or better than, humans. Later he explained the Machine learning related application of artificial intelligence, in which a computer is provided programming and large amounts of data to learn its own patterns, rather than the patterns and limits set by a human programmer, and thereby improve from experience. He covered the application of AI to medical tasks that has exploded in recent years owing to advances in computing power, hardware capabilities, and software advances.

In the afternoon session he explored the Businesses and other Institutions which are able to store most of their data in Microsoft Excel Sheets and also about the modest Business Intelligence tools capable of analyzing and processing this data. He also covered how the presence of a lesser amount of data made the handling and managing of data easier but, with the passage of time, the amount of data produced every day kept increasing.
